Steering Group Update:

This week the steering group were joined by Mrs Craig to discuss the new playground timetables and to revise the playground rules. The children discussed use of the bottom playground for football to agree a fair compromise for all children to be able to enjoy this opportunity.

Following this the children came up with the following playground rules:

- Bottom playground to be used by KS2 on Monday, Wednesday and Friday and by KS1 on Tuesday and Thursday.
- Football games to be on a timetable to ensure that all years have playing time.
- A set of football rules should be written to give to mid-day meal supervisors to ensure that the game is being refereed.
- Sports leaders to run games on Thursday's and Friday's.
- A set area to be created on the playground so children can play ball games such as tennis.
- Adults should treat children with fairness and respect.
- Children should treat adults with fairness and respect.
- If anyone has a worry or concern that doesn't need immediate attention from a teacher, then they should put their concern in the worry box and this will be addressed by a member of staff at another time.
- When on the playground everyone should look out for one another.
- Equipment should be treated with respect. Children should make sure that they take in equipment that they have been using on the playground.

These amended rules will be put into place following half term and the children will support Miss Carlow in delivering an assembly to share these rules.
