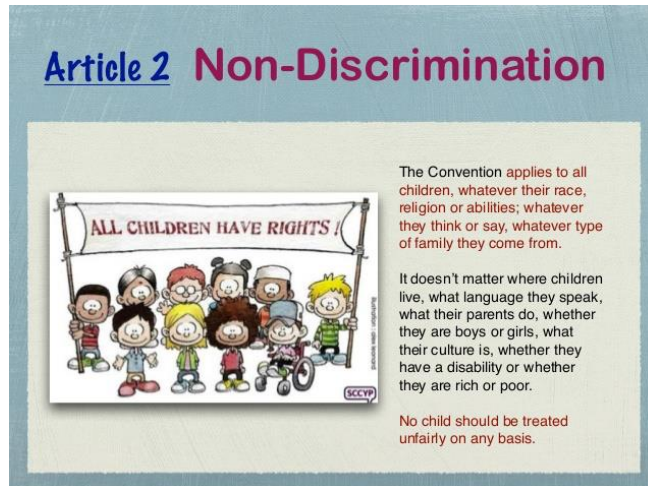


Rights Respecting School Award

This week the children continued to explore the school's article focus 'Article 2 Non-Discrimination'. To extend their learning surrounding this article, the children took part in a number of assemblies, exploring topics such as dignity and equity. The children discussed how they can ensure that they treat one another with fairness and dignity in school and how adults in school make sure that mutual respect is fostered.
