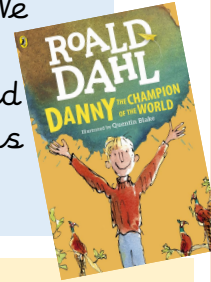


English

This term we are going to be exploring Roald Dahl's 'Danny Champion of the World'. We are going to be analysing language choices made by the author, considering how we could use this vocabulary to develop our own writing. We will also be using drama and discussion to empathise with characters and to extend our ability to comprehend the text and to allow us to write for a range of purposes and audiences. (Articles, 28, 29, 12)



Art

In art, we are going to be exploring the work of Henri Rousseau - focussing on his depictions of the rainforest. We will be studying the colours and textures that he creates and will be using this to inspire our own painting of the rainforest. (Article 29)

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Geography

This term and following into term 2 we are going to be exploring the rainforest. We are going to be looking at where the rainforests are in the world, the rainforest as a habitat, its structure and will also be focussing on issues such as deforestation. (Article 17, 28)

Maths

This term we are going to be extending our knowledge of place value by reading, ordering and comparing numbers up to 1,000,000. We will then use this knowledge to support us in adding and subtracting with increasingly large numbers, using both mental and formal written methods. (Articles 28 and 29)



RE/PSHE

In RE we are going to be looking at Christianity, focussing on the story of creation.

Our PSHE focus is on strengthening communities, where we will be exploring what a community is and what communities we belong to. We will also be discussing the role of our rights in day to day life. (Articles 14, 30 and 15)

Computing

This term we are going to be using technology for research and presentation. We are going to be using a range of programmes to allow us to do this and will be conducting safe internet searches. (Article 17)

PE

In PE this term, we will be developing our netball skills, including: defending, marking, attacking, shooting, passing and ball skills. (Article 29)

Science

This term we are going to be exploring Earth and Space, focussing on the Earth, moon and planets in our solar system. We will be looking at the Earth as a spherical object, as well as exploring the phases of the moon and how we get night and day, using our scientific skills, including practical activities and enquiry, and research to develop our knowledge of this. (Article 28, 29)
